### **1-GENERAL INFORMATIONS**

Il **DOG TRAIL LMIT** is organized by A.S.D. Val Veddasca e MolineraRunning.

This event is sponsored by Comunità Montana Valli delVerbano e del Comune di Maccagno con Pino e Veddasca (Varese).

There are two competitive Races:

\* **DOG TRAIL LMIT - K 20 D+ 1.430 m**

\* **DOG TRAIL LMIT - K 12 D+ 700 m**

The **DOG TRAIL LMIT** implies a good harmony between the dog and its conductor which leads to a perfect understanding between the two; it is therefore necessary that the participants possess the basic elements of education and obedience.

The **DOG TRAIL LMIT** it is a competition of resistance on routes normally used for mountain hiking, due to the elevation profile that for the type of rough terrain on which one runs, the event is particularly demanding.

Asphalted roads are generally avoided, except for the initial and final part of the event.

To safeguard the health of the dog and ensure a smooth running of the race, the temperature at the start must not exceed 25°. Il direttore della manifestazione si riserva di modificare il percorso se la temperatura dovesse oltrepassare il suindicato limite.

The event director reserves the right to cancel the Dog Trail LMIT K20 / K12 in the event that the temperature at 12.00 on May 1st should exceed the maximum limit of 25 °, and the weather forecast will confirm the same conditions for the following day.

In case of deletion of the Dog Trail LMIT K20 / K12 The organization of the LMIT will give the possibility to the members of the Dog Trail LMIT K20 / K12 to choose the transfer of their registration to the to the LMIminiT K20 or to the LMIT K12 "not competitive".

The transfer of your registration can be requested at the "Central Station", only and exclusively on Saturday May 1st 2020 from 15:00 to 18:00.

## **2 - PRIZES**

There are no cash prizes. The prizes are cumulative.

Prizes are awarded in kind / technical accessories / technical clothing / cups.

At the end of the race, however, the general rankings are drawn up with the arrival times and published on the WWW.LMIT.INFO website. The only categories are "men" and "women".

We will reward:

- The first 5 men and the first 5 absolute women of thefor DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20;
- The first 3 men and the first 3 absolute women of theDOG TRAIL LMIT Km 12.

## **3- CATEGORIES**

Categories refer to each runner's birthday (not to January 1st).

Categories are defined as follows:

Juniors 18-19 year old (at least 18 y.o. but younger than 20 y.o.);

Master-M M20 (20-24 y.o.), M25 (25-29 y.o.), M30 (30-34 y.o.),M35 (35-39 y.o.), M40 (40-44 y.o.), M45 (45-49 y.o.), M50 (50-54 y.o.), M55 (55-59 y.o.), M60 (60-64 y.o.), M65 (65-69 y.o.), M70 (70-74 y.o.), M75 (75-79 y.o.), M80 (80-84 y.o.) ecc.

Master-F F20 (20-24 y.o.), F25 (25-29 y.o.), F30 (30-34 y.o.),F35 (35-39 y.o.), F40 (40-44 y.o.), F45 (45-49 y.o.), F50 (50-54 y.o.), F55 (55-59 y.o.), F60 (60-64 y.o.), F65 (65-69 y.o.), F70 (70-74 y.o.) ecc.

## **4 - TRACKS**

The tracks, which we report below, are classified as follows:

**DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20 / Km 12:** C.A.I. definition: "E - Hiking itinerary. Itinerary that is almost always carried out on trails or on varied terrain (pastures, debris, screens) with signs. It sometimes develops on open but not difficult terrain. It can take place on steep slopes."

These two tracks include parts with Alpine difficulties

The "DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20" race route follows the following itinerary through the territory of the municipality of Maccagno with Pino and Veddasca (VA), more precisely:

- **START: Maccagno con Pino e Veddasca (Parco delle Feste) - 206 m**
- Garabiolo (Maccagno con Pino e Veddasca) - 566 m
- Alpe Inent - 704 m
- Centrale Enel di smistamento (località Musignano)
- Diga Sud Lago Delio - 930 m
- Monte Cradrigna – 1300 m
- Passo Forcora - 1200 m
- Diga Nord Lago Delio - 930 m
- Diga Sud Lago Delio - 930 m
- Musignano - 721 m
- Sarangio - 534 m
- Entiglio - 299 m
- Palestra di Rocca “Cinzanino”
- **FINISH LINE: Maccagno con Pino e Veddasca (Parco delle Feste) - 206 m**

**TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS: 2% asphalt - 98% paths.**

The "DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 12" race route follows the following itinerary through the territory of the municipality of Maccagno with Pino and Veddasca (VA), more precisely:

- Maccagno con Pino e Veddasca – Sport field (206m)
- Frazione Garabiolo (566m)
- Ostello “Comunità Montana”
- Frazione Musignano (746m)
- Frazione Sarangio (534m)
- Maccagno con Pino e Veddasca – Campo Sportivo (206m)

**TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS: 3% asphalt - 97% paths.**

In both trails the kilometers are not marked. In this regard it is advisable to study well the description of the route provided by the Organization and downloadable from the official website, as well as the relative tracks available on the official website [WWW.LMIT.INFO](http://WWW.LMIT.INFO).

Competitors must strictly comply with the competition route marked by orange biodegradable paint marks (2 overlapping vertical or horizontal rods or arrows), orange-colored rods or yellow / black ribbons.

Any signs of different colors must be neglected as they indicate paths that are not related to the DOG TRAIL LMIT.

If you don't meet those signs for a distance of about 300 meters, you must go back to make sure you are on the correct path. To abandon the official route, in addition to entailing disqualification from the race, will take place at the exclusive risk and danger of the competitor.

## **5 - DOGS**

The **DOG TRAIL LMIT** is a discipline open to all dogs with or without pedigree, but necessarily equipped with a microchip (the microchip can also be referred to a third person).

Won't be allowed to take part to the event

- Female dogs in the gestation period;
- Females dogs in oestrus;
- Dogs that have obvious illnesses or injuries;I cani dopati.

Dogs must be in possession of a "Health Book" or a valid "Pet Passport"

Minimum requested age of the dogs:

- 15 months.

Maximum allowed age of the dos:

- 10year.

## **6 – VETERINARY VISITS**

The presentation of the dogs to the pre-race veterinary visits must take place from 8:00 a.m. to 09:20 a.m.

The preliminary visit has the purpose of checking the identity of the dog through the "Health Book" or the "Passport for pets" and the microchip, and to determine if it is in a position to participate in the tender.

Dogs must be presented at post-race veterinary visits within 10 minutes of arrival.

The final visit will determine if the dog is still in good physical condition.

Dogs that do not pass one of the two aforementioned visits will be considered "unsuitable", therefore disqualified from the competition.

## **7 - MEDICAL CONDUCTORS CERTIFICATION**

In order to proceed with the race pick-up, it is mandatory to give a photocopy of the sports medical certificate for the competitive activity with a deadline not before the date of the competition, as well as a valid identification document.

The certificate must be delivered exclusively upon collection of the bib and must not be sent to the organization by e-mail, fax or post.

It is not necessary, even less, to present the FIDAL card or another Federation or Sports Promotion Agency.

Participation in "LMI" , "LMImini" and DOG TRAIL is not allowed to those who do not provide a photocopy of the sports medical certificate for the competitive activity.

For foreign athletes, the corresponding certificate issued in the country of origin is valid. A form to be filled and signed by your Doctor is available for download by [clicking HERE](#).

## **8 – HELD IN THE COMPETITION**

The handler will have to adapt to the speed of the dog. It is forbidden to tow the dog.

The dog must wear a sports bib. The use of the collar is prohibited.

The handler must have a waist belt where it is mandatory to apply the leash - cushioned line - which will have a maximum length of 2 meters.

The conductor have to collect his dog's droppings in urban areas during the event and the competition, while on the paths it is sufficient to move them to the margins.

The handler cannot use poles.

## **9 –SUBSCRIPTIONS**

**Subscribers who enrolled at DT LMIT 2020 and required the conversion to LMIT 2021 (OPTION 1) or asked for the 25% discount (OPTION 2) can activate their DT LMIT 2021 subscription the way indicated at the Chapter 11 of these official rules**

All athletes who have reached the age of 18 can register for the DOG TRAIL LMIT K20 / K12.

Registrations will open on November 10, 2020 and will close at 24:00 on April 18, 2020 (**or when reaching 100 total competitors**).

Registration is personal and definitive, it is valid only for the chosen race, bib numbers and / or replacement of names are not allowed.

Entries will be submitted for approval by the Competition Organizers.

Anyone who has taken offensive behavior of any kind against the Organizing Association, the Competition and / or other Competitors will be liable for non-acceptance of the application form for one or more events organized by A.S.D. Val Veddasca and Molinera Running.

The judgment of acceptance or refusal of registrations is definitive.

The closing of entries will be announced on the website WWW.LMIT.INFO and from that moment further registrations will no longer be accepted.

The registered members list will be published on the site and kept constantly updated.

To subscribe to **DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20 e Km 12** you have to:

- be aware of the length and characteristics of the race;
- be perfectly trained to deal with it;
- having acquired, before the race, a real capacity for personal autonomy in the mountains to be able to better manage the problems deriving from adverse weather conditions (wind, fog, rain, cold, snow);
- being able to manage physical or mental problems caused by great fatigue, muscle or joint pain, small wounds, etc .;
- be aware that the Organization's role is not to help a runner manage these problems.

## **10 – SUBSCRIPTION FEES**

**12 – CHANGE OF THE RACE**

In case that an athlete regularly registered, for exceptional reasons, needs to change the competition, the procedure to follow is the following:

the Athlete must submit to the Organization, via e-mail, a request to change the race only after having provided for the regularization of any payment difference in favor of the Organization.

**13 – BIB AND RACE PACK WITHDRAWAL**

The bib and race package withdrawal operations will take place at the “Parco delle Feste” (close to the sports field) of Maccagno with Pino and Veddasca:

**Saturday May1st, 2021 :**



- 3pm – 6 pm BIB and race pack withdrawal for **DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20 / DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 12**;
- 3pm – 6pm latest subscriptions for **DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20 / DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 12 only in case of BIB available still**).

**Sunday, May 2nd 2021:**

- 8:30 – 9:30am BIB and race pack withdrawal for **DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20 / DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 12**.

#### **14 – RACE START**

The departure and arrival of the DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20 / DOG TRAIL LMIT 12 Km will take place in Maccagno with Pino and Veddasca (VARESE) at the "Parco delle Feste" (adjacent to the sports field).

Competitors must present themselves for the punching of the bibs at the Wedosport timekeepers stand, set up near the starting line by 9:40 am;

**RACE START FOR DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20 e Km 12: 09:50 am.**

#### **15 – TIME LIMIT**

Time limit is **4:30 hours for DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20** and **2:45 hours for DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 12**.

There is a "broom service" that will follow the track following the last couple, so as to be helpful to any retreats and to prevent any injured persons from being left without assistance.

For **DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20** there's the following "time gate":

- at 12:25 Passo Forcora (km 10,5 max time 2h35').

For **DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 12** there are no "time gates".

For **DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20 e DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 12** operations of control of the binomial could be surprisingly set up along the way (at the discretion of the Organization).

The pairs that pass at the gate beyond the maximum time can continue by delivering the bib number without assistance.

The area where the time gate is located can be reached by car or by the Civil Protection means, and therefore it is a point where the couple, not in a position to continue, can withdraw.

In the event of withdrawal during the race, it is compulsory to notify the race staff present along the route as soon as possible and to deliver the bib number, then it will be possible to continue exclusively under one's own responsibility and in complete autonomy.

In the event of failure to notify a withdrawal and the consequent start of the search for the binomial, any expense arising will be charged to the runner himself.

The evacuation of the pairs who leave the race, or who cannot overcome the "time gate" in good time, is subject to the availability of means of transport, the priorities of the race, the meteorological situation, etc. There is therefore no right to be evacuated immediately unless it is an emergency medical evacuation.

## **16 - OBLIGATIONS AND ADVICE (MANDATORY STUFF)**

It is important to know that in case of need for assistance, the morphology of the territory or the current weather conditions could make rescue efforts wait longer than expected. Security will then depend on the material you will have in your backpack or pouch.

For **DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20** you have to bring with you the following stuff:

- cellphone with the Organizers' contact saved in ( **+39 327 9303569** ) – mandatory;
- at least 1l drinks – mandatory;
- BIB with race number well visible – mandatory;
- Wind jacket able to face hard weather conditions on the mountains (*we reserve the right to make it mandatory*);
- Thermal blanket – mandatory;
- Food storage – mandatory;
- Emergency whistle – mandatory;
- Track description, or track route available at [WWW.LMIT.INFO](http://WWW.LMIT.INFO) (free download) – mandatory;
- Running pants or tights that cover the knee can limit abrasion damage due to an accidental fall – highly suggested;
- Trailrunning shoes (flagged as A5, they represent the ideal footwear for this kind of journey) – highly suggested;
- Hat or headband – highly suggested;
- personal glass or cup as there are no glasses of any kind in the refreshment points – highly suggested;
- equipment suitable for dog management.

For **DOG TRAIL LMIT Km12** you have to bring with you the following stuff:

- cellphone with the Organizers' contact saved in ( **+39 327 9303569** );
- at least 0,5 l drinks;
- Wind jacket able to face hard weather conditions on the mountains (we reserve the right to make it mandatory);
- Thermal blanket;
- Food storage;
- Emergency whistle;
- personal glass or cup as there are no glasses of any kind in the refreshment points – highly suggested;

- equipment suitable for dog management.

PLEASE NOTE...Before departure, a member of the Staff will carry out checks on the mandatory equipment. If the competitor does not possess the mandatory equipment he will be disqualified and will not be able to start.

### **17 - SEMI SELF-SUFFICIENCY**

Semi-autonomy is defined as the ability to be autonomous between two refreshment points, in terms of safety, equipment and nutrition / hydration.

**Although along the way there are several points of natural water and liquid / solid refreshment, (see art. 18), the principle of competitions (DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20 / DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 12) in semi-sufficiency is the rule.**

### **18 – REFRESHMENT POINT**

The race takes place with water-food assistance.

The **DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 20** will have the following refreshment points:

- **Passo Forcora / liquid + solid(km 10,5);**
- **Finish Line / liquid.**

The **DOG TRAIL LMIT Km 12** will have the following refreshment point:

- **Finish Line / liquid.**

The athletes will have to throw in the special containers made available at the refreshment points: waste, glasses, gels, bars, etc.

Anyone who is caught throwing something out of the containers will be disqualified.

### **19 - RACE ASSISTANCE / SAFETY / COLLABORATIONS**

The assistance and security is prepared and managed by the organizers, in collaboration with:

- Associazione Nazionale Carabinieri – Sezione di Luino;
- CAI/Sezione di Luino;
- CAI/Sezione di Gallarate;
- Circolo ACLI di Garabio (Maccagno con Pino e Veddasca);
- Corpo Nazionale Alpino e Speleologico/Stazione di Varese;
- Nucleo Protezione Civile e Ambiente Carabinieri in Congedo – Provincia di Varese;
- Protezione Civile di Maccagno con Pino e Veddasca;

- Protezione Civile di Tronzano Lago Maggiore;
- Protezione Civile Intercomunale Val Dumentina;
- A.S.D. Polisportiva Valdumentina;
- Associazione Nazionale Carabinieri – Sezione di Lavena Ponte Tresa;
- Pro Loco di Maccagno con Pino e Veddasca.

An ambulance will be present in the arrival area.

Athletes are required to have orientation and self-management skills in the mountains, even in bad weather conditions.

Every athlete, injured or in difficulty, or for the same difficulties concerning their dog, can call for help:

- presenting themselves at an official checkpoint or at the Assistants of the course;
- by calling the organization number (+39 327 9303569);
- asking another athlete to notify the rescue team.

It is a must and obligatory to provide assistance to all the people in need and, if necessary, to notify the rescue team. In the event that a competitor has lost time to rescue another injured or struggling competitor, he can request the Race Time Jury to reduce the time spent on the official classification.

## **20 - PENALTIES AND DISQUALIFICATIONS**

The Organization staff members present on the course are authorized to verify the compliance of the riders with the regulations and to communicate to the race jury the infringements found. The race jury applies the penalties according to the following table. The time penalties are applied immediately at the end of the race or in the following days with additional time shown on the official ranking.

## **21 - ENVIRONMENT**



Competitors must behave in a manner that respects the alpine environment, avoiding in particular to disperse waste, collect flowers or harass wildlife. Anyone surprised to leave litter along the way will be disqualified from the race and will incur any penalties provided for by municipal regulations.

## **22 - WEATHER**

The race will take place in any weather condition. In the event of significant weather phenomena (thunderstorms, snow), the Organization reserves the right to make changes to the course even at the last minute so as to eliminate any dangers or conditions of great difficulty for the participants. Any changes will be communicated to the participants and reported by the employees.

## **23 - GYM AND SHOWERS FOR EXCLUSIVE USE OF DRIVERS**

At the municipal gym of Maccagno with Pino and Veddasca, via Oliari nr.1, there are no cots or mats provided.

The gym and shower rooms are not controlled, therefore the Organization is not responsible for any theft or damage to objects left unattended.

It is mandatory to leave the gym as you found it, without leaving waste and cleaning up the spaces, equipment and services used.

## **24 - ASSURANCE**

The Organization is in charge of a civil liability insurance policy and for the protection of the participants throughout the trial period.

Any costs arising from the use of rescue vehicles are the responsibility of the rescued person, as well as those for his return from the place where he was hospitalized. It is advisable to take out a special insurance policy to cover above all helicopter rescue and rescue costs.

## **25 - DECLARATION OF RESPONSIBILITY'**

The voluntary registration and the consequent participation in the race indicate the full acceptance of this regulation and of any changes made. By registering, the participant exempts the Organizers from any liability, both civil and criminal, for damage to persons and / or things caused by him or to him. For minors, this declaration is issued by a parent or guardian at the time of collection of the race number and race pack.

## **26 - DISCLAIMER**

When collecting the race number and race pack, the athlete must sign a release of liability release.

## **27-IMAGE RIGHTS**

By registering, the competitors authorize the Organization to use, for free, without territorial and time limits, still and moving images that portray them on the occasion of participation in the "Lago Maggiore International Trail" and the "Lago Maggiore International mini Between".

## **28- PRIVACY POLICY**

The data provided will be treated in compliance with the rules established by Legislative Decree 30.06.2003 nr. 196 and used exclusively for the purposes related to the tender.

## **29 - TIMEKEEPING**

The Timekeeping service will be provided by Wedosport.

## **30 - COMPLAINTS**

We only accept complaints presented in a written form within 30 minutes of the last competitor's arrival time, with a deposit of € 50.00.

## **31 – JURY**

The jury is composed by:

- The Race Director;
- A 1st Level Canicross Technician authorized by the national council;
- A Vet;
- All the people chosen by the Organizers.

The jury is authorized to deliberate in a time compatible with the obligations of the race on all disputes or disqualifications occurred during the race. The decisions taken are without appeal.

## **32 – VARIATIONS**

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to modify this regulation at any time for reasons it deems appropriate for a better organization of the competition.
